NDSU STUDENTS—graduate as well as undergraduate—are invited to submit original creative work for possible publication in *Northern Eclecta*, Volume 6, which will be issued in the summer of 2012.

Anyone registered for at least three credits at NDSU during Summer Session 2011, Fall Semester 2011, and/or Spring Semester 2012 is eligible to submit.

You may submit works in multiple categories, but only one work per person will be accepted for print publication with this exception: people whose work is accepted in the Quick Takes category (very short fiction, nonfiction, and poetry) may also have a second submission published in the Fiction, Nonfiction, Poetry, Photography, or Art categories.

- **FICTION:** one or two stories. This category includes all works of fiction including short plays and screenplays (or possibly excerpts of them). Very short fiction (500 words or less) is included in the Quick Takes category; pieces in the Fiction category are at least 500 words but not more than approximately 3500 words. At the top of the first page, please type “Fiction.” Please give a title to any fiction stories. Save each story as a separate file.
- **CREATIVE NONFICTION:** one or two pieces. Although based on fact, creative nonfiction uses literary devices such as dialogue, description, and possibly symbolism to tell a story. This category includes genres such as personal essays, memoirs, and travel writing. Very short nonfiction (500 words or less) is included in the Quick Takes category; creative nonfiction pieces should be at least 500 words but not more than approximately 3500 words. At the top of the first page, please type “Nonfiction.” Please give a title to any creative nonfiction. Save each essay as a separate file.
- **POETRY:** up to four poems. Please submit a separate document for each poem. At the top of the page, please type “Poetry.” Please give a title to each poem. Save each poem as a separate file.
- **QUICK TAKES: VERY SHORT FICTION, NONFICTION, AND POETRY:** up to six pieces (any combination). This category includes very short fiction [e.g. six-word short stories, extreme flash fiction of 500 words or less], very short nonfiction [e.g. six-word essays, extreme flash nonfiction of 500 words or less], and short poetry [e.g. haiku, acrostic (vertical) poetry, and other short poems]. At the top of the page, please type “Quick Takes.” Please give titles to all works **except** for six-word short stories and six-word nonfiction essays. Please indicate whether six-word stories are “Fiction” or “Nonfiction.” If you submit multiple works in this category, they may all be included in the same file.
- **PHOTOGRAPHY:** up to three photographs. Photographs must be submitted electronically: .jpg or .tiff files of 300 dpi or greater are preferred. Please give titles to all photographs. Last year we published 50% of the visual arts selections in color and 50% of them in black & white, so both formats are welcome.
- **ART:** up to three pieces of artwork. Artwork must be submitted electronically: .jpg or .tiff files of 300 dpi or greater are preferred. Please give titles to all art. Last year we published 50% of the visual arts selections in color and 50% of them in black & white, so both formats are welcome.

SUBMISSION DIRECTIONS

- **Preparing Written Categories:**
 1. Please type the name of the category at the top of the first page (i.e. Fiction, Nonfiction, Poetry, Quick Takes).
 2. Save these submissions as MS Word files (2003, 2007, or 2010 format is fine) or as an .rtf or .txt file.
 3. Each Fiction, Nonfiction, and Poetry submission should be submitted as a separate file; however, multiple submissions in the Quick Takes category may be included in the same file.

- **Preparing Visual Categories:**
 1. Save image files as .jpg or .tiff files; 300 dpi or greater is preferred.
 2. Please include a title for each of these by either naming the file with the title and/or by including the title of the image(s) in your email message.

You will receive an acknowledgement of your submission within 3-5 days. Notice of acceptance or rejection will be sent to your email address by the middle of April.

By submitting your work, you are verifying that your work is original (produced by you and not plagiarized) and that you have the right to distribute the material. Upon publication, all subsequent rights return to the contributor with future print acknowledgment to *Northern Eclecta*.
